## RoGEP

We now have agreement for those applying for [RoGEP Professional Grade](#) at the same time as for CGeol will be able to submit their application for both to the GSL. Scrutineers will have an added assessment form to complete which will then be sent to RoGEP for acceptance onto the Register.

The new RoGEP application system will require us to provide [Scrutineers](#) who are on RoGEP at Specialist or Adviser Grade. Those Fellows who hold these qualifications, and are not already Scrutineers, are invited to apply to join the Scrutineers Panel so that we will be able to service these applications without too much pressure on a small group. Please find the information for Scrutineers on the web site and send in an application or contact me and I will send the information.

We are also short of Scrutineers who hold the CSci title. It is a requirement of the Science Council that at least one Scrutineer for a CSci application is a CSci themselves. I would therefore be very grateful to hear from Fellows offering to help as Scrutineers for CGeol, CSci and RoGEP.
